Airthings has established its B2C footprint sales with giants like Amazon and Home Depot and forged robust B2B alliances with large enterprises. The company became publicly traded in 2020.

"Øyvind has played an instrumental role in building Airthings into the successful company it is today. He has been an impressive leader of the company for nearly a decade. On behalf of the board, I want to sincerely thank him for his dedication, passion, hard work and job extremely well done," added Førre.

"It's been an amazing ride," said Birkenes. "From the early days as a startup to become a scale-up listed on the Oslo Stock Exchange. I'm very proud to have led Airthings through these years. Now, as the company shifts gears with a revised strategy, Airthings 3.0, it's time for me to pass the baton on and welcome Emma, who will lead Airthings through its next phase."
